



HAZARDOUS AREAS

Hazardous areas refer to an area where an explosive atmosphere can be present, or may be expected to be present.

Examples include petrol stations, spray paint shops, sewerage treatment plants, refineries and major processing facilities, grain or coal handling facilities.

The owner of a hazardous area must ensure any electrical installation meets the required safety standards and is audited by an accredited auditor.

Penalties for non-compliance include up to \$1,000,000 in fines or three year's imprisonment.
